for it. Common sense right? Now that
George is old & sickly, they want to
throw him and me to the wolves!!!
George is diabetic - 2 different insulins,
4 shots a day, he's had triple CABG
surgery, 2 MI's, 11 TIA's, 2 strokes
& gallbladder surgery, hernia repaired
x 2, Lens implants x 2 & now he has
Alzheimer's & dementia. He takes 15
different meds a day. Every year it's a
fight to get them to pay for something.
Now its his drupt 23, Humalog insulin
& Sanctura XL for overactive bladder. They
drive me crazy with having a time getting

his medicine paid for. I've devoted my life to taking care of him. I've nursed him back from everything. I can't nurse him back from the Alzheimer's. He's slipping a little every day. It's so hard to watch but I will care for him until I keel over! I'm starting to fall apart now. When I need my insurance the most & they want to do away with it! I say NO! We are God fearing, honest, hard working people who believe in working hard for what you have & praying you'll leave a legacy of God's love & kindness & mercy behind.

This case scares me to death! If you allow them to take our benefits I don't know what we will do! He worked so hard for our benefits & now when we need them the most they want to take it from us. The contract he retired ^{now} promised 100% coverage - ~~you~~ ^{me} in deductibles for life! Not 80/20, 70/30 or whatever they want. I punch numbers so tight Abe Lincoln screams for mercy! We live a simple life. We aren't extravagant. We've never in 29 yrs had a vacation

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Our activity of choice is going to church
& trying to serve the Lord. Please
take in to consideration what we
told you. This would not only devastate
us but about 20,000 others too.
It will destroy economy in the area
& every thing. I pray you'll make the
right decision.
